<p>Indications: Rocky mountain spotted fever, typhus fever and the typhus group, Q fever, rickettsialpox, and tick fevers Respiratory tract infections, Lymphogranuloma venereum, Psittacosis, Trachoma, Inclusion conjunctivitis etc</p>			
<p>Side-effects: Anorexia, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, glossitis, dysphagia, enterocolitis, and inflammatory lesions Photosensitivity, Hypersensitivity Reactions, Bulging fontanel in infants and intracranial hypertension in adults</p>			
<p>Precautions: Impaired hepatic function, oral candidiasis, should be taken in upright position to avoid esophageal injury</p>			
<p>Contra-indications: children < 8 yrs, pregnancy, lactation, hypersensitivity to tetracycline, prolonged exposure to sunlight</p>			
<p>Overdose: discontinue medication, treat symptomatically and institute supportive measures.</p>			
<p>How to take: Drink a full glass of water with each dose. Continue to take doxycycline even if you feel well</p>
