<p>Indications: peptic ulcer disease and/or reflux esophagitis, symptomatic GERD, Helicobacter pylori-positive duodenal ulcer disease and H.pylori-positive gastric ulcer disease, Zollinger-Ellison syndrome, gastroduodenal ulceration associated with NSAIDS</p>			
<p>Side-effects: headache, abdominal pain, nausea, diarrhea, vomiting, and flatulence. regurgitation, upper respiratory infection, constipation, dizziness, rash, asthenia, back pain, and cough</p>			
<p>Precautions: Malignancy, hepatic impairment, Pregnancy, children, neonates</p>			
<p>Contra-indications: Hypersensitivity, Lactation</p>			
<p>Overdose: Treatment should be symptomatic and supportive.</p>			
<p>How to take: Swallow the regular omeprazole capsules with water. Do not swallow the capsules with any other liquid</p>
