Indications: Rocky mountain spotted fever, typhus fever and the typhus group, Q fever,rickettsialpox, and tick fevers

Respiratory tract infections, Lymphogranuloma venereum, Psittacosis,

Respiratory tract injections, <mark>Lymphogranulo</mark>ma venereum, Ps

Trachoma ,Inclusion conjunctivitis etc

Side-effects: Anorexia, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, glossitis, dysphagia, enterocolitis, and inflammatory lesions Photosensitivity, Hypersensitivity Reactions, Bulging fontanels in infants and

intracranial hypertension in adults

Precautions: Impaired hepatic function, oral candidiasis, should be taken in upright position to avoid esophageal injury

Contra-indications: chilgn<8yrs, pregnancy, lactation, hypesensitivity to tetracyline, prolonged exposure to sunlight

Overdose: discontinue medication, treat symptomatically and institute supportive measures.

How to take: Drink a full glass of water with each dose. Continue to take doxycycline even if you feel well
