1 Gm	Meropenem USP ( As Trihydrate ) Eq. to 1000 mg 90.2 mg of sodium as sodium carnobate	Antibiotic	Carbapenem
<b>Indications:</b> SSTI, Intra-abdominal Infections, meningitis, LRTI, UTI, Septicemia, Febrile neutropenia, nosocomial and community acquired pneumonia

<b>Side-effects:</b> diarrhea, nausea/vomiting, headache, rash, sepsis , constipation, apnea, shock, pruritus, Hematologic - agranulocytosis, neutropenia, and leukopenia. Skin - toxic epidermal necrolysis. Local- Phlebitis, pain etc			
<b>Precautions:</b> Hypersensitivity to carbapenems or other beta lactams, infants < 3 months, renal insufficiency, neurological disorders, pregnancy , lactation, not recommended for MRSA			
<b>Contra-indications:</b> Hypersensitivity
