Indications: conjunctiv<mark>itis -Gram-po</mark>sitive bacteria: S. aureus, S. epidermidis, S. pneumoniae.

Gram-negative bacteria: H. influenzae.

Side-effects: ocular burning or discomfort, ocular redness, stinging, itching, photophobia, tearing and dryness

Precautions: may result in overgrowth of nonsusceptible organisms, including fungi. Anaphylatic reactions

Pregnancy, Lactation, children

Contra-indications: history of hypersensitivity to ofloxacin, quinolones

Storage: Store at 15 to 25 C.

How to take: To apply to eye. Not meant for injection in eye
