Indications: reduce intraocular pressure in patients with chronic open-angle glaucoma; patients with ocular hypertension; aphakic patients having glaucoma, patients with narrow angle closure in the opposite eye

Side-effects: ocular irritation including burning and stinging, conjunctivitis, blepharitis, keratitis, decreased corneal sensitivity, and dry eyes. Refractive changes, Respiratory: bronchospasm, Hypersensitivity, systemic beta blockade (CVS)

Precautions: Choroidal Detachment, preservatives may be absorbed by soft contact lenses, Risk from Anaphylactic Reaction may mask certain clinical signs of hyperthyroidism, major surgery, pregnancy, lactation, children

Contra-indications: Bronchospasm, cardiogenic shock,

Hypersensitivity

Storage: Store at room temperature (15 to 25 C). Protect from light.
